Please review the following information:

- Vendors can **arrive between 8:45-9:15am** to setup. All tables should be ready to go by 9:45! Vendors are asked to stay until the event ends at **2:00pm**.
- Resource Fair Partners & Mindful Market Vendors will each have a **10x10ft** space to set up your table/booth. Vendors are asked to **provide your own tents, tables, and chairs**, along with all materials you wish to hand out/sell.
- You are welcome to park along 5th St (the west side of Jarboe Park) or in the Beaches Chapel School parking lot (610 Florida Blvd).
- We will have plenty of water and you are welcome to purchase refreshments from the food trucks, but feel free to bring any food/drinks for yourself!
- It will likely be hot - bring any items you need like sunscreen or portable fans.
- The event is **RAIN or SHINE!** In the event of adverse weather, vendors are asked to shelter under your tent or in Neptune House, the building in Jarboe Park located next to the location of our Resource Fair. *All help in manifesting fantastic weather for our 2026 ECHO Fair is appreciated!*
- We encourage you to **promote the event within your communities and/or on social media** to help us spread the word about this opportunity!
